

Volunteer Position Description:

Small Craft Junior Facilitator | Archery, Slingshot, & Hatchet Junior Facilitator

Purpose: To create leadership engagements for girls that enhance the Girl Scout Leadership experience by giving girls the training and opportunities that they need to support activities within their troops, service units and communities.

Commitment To:

- Volunteers
- Girl Members
- Your Community
- GSCB

Duration: Upon successfully completing the required training, qualification is active for two years.

Responsibilities & Duties:

- Serve as a Qualified Assistant in supporting activities in which you are trained
 - Qualified Assistant is defined as: a junior facilitator OR a registered member who is 18 years of age, background checked, able to take direction from the facilitator and supports the activity by putting on safety devices, prepping equipment, and serves as an anchor in the processions of boats, managing the rear of the group.
- Support other duties as assigned by Facilitator
- Understand that activities must be facilitated by an Adult Facilitator, and a Junior Facilitator may act as a Qualified Assistant in support and cannot be the sole facilitator.

Training Requirements:

- Small Craft – complete online and in person training to comply with GSUSA Small Craft Safety Training Requirements that GSCB is embracing.
- Archery – complete online and in person training to comply with USA Archery guidelines.
 - Slingshot – included in Archery training
 - Hatchet – included in Archery training when offered at Grove Point.

General Requirements:

- Be a registered girl scout
- Be at least 15 years of age for Archery (per USAA) and at least 14 years of age for Small Craft
- Be an Ambassador, Senior, or bridging Cadette
- Behave in a manner that upholds the Girl Scout Promise & Law in all interactions with the public, Girl Scout members, and GSCB staff.
- Be punctual when arriving to events where you are serving as a Junior Facilitator
