Challenge Course Supervisor

Purpose: To partner with GSCB, supporting oversight of GSCB's Challenge Course(s). Ensuring the appropriate safety and maintenance requirements are met, diminishing the risk of injury associated with such activities.

Commitment To:

Duration: In line with the Association for Challenge Course Technology standards, this role is good for 5 years under the condition that High Ropes and Zipline Facilitator training is completed annually and the hours requirement for facilitation is met.

Responsibilities & Duties:

- Serve as a coach for new Zipline and High Ropes Facilitators
- Provide education around safety considerations, educational objectives, program objectives, event setup and presentation, and how to prepare for zipline and high ropes activities
- Adhere to all safety requirements outlined in Safety Activity Checkpoints
- Follow all GSCB policies and procedures
- Observe regular site inspections with Vestal Gap Ventures staff
- Care for equipment and report any issues to GSCB via Member Care
- Partner with GSCB staff to develop and regularly maintain inventory management system
- Perform quarterly checks of equipment and report issues to GSCB staff
- Encourage volunteers to become High Ropes and Zipline Facilitators
- Support GSCB initiatives to grow our High Ropes and Zipline offerings or equipment needs, as relevant

Training Requirements:

- Current High Ropes and Zipline Facilitator with at least 3 years of experience
- Current First Aid/CPR certification
- Additional training from Vestal Gap Ventures as available or necessary

General Requirements:

- Be a registered girl scout volunteer
- Have an active background check
- Behave in a manner that upholds the Girl Scout Promise & Law in all interactions with the public, Girl Scout members, and GSCB staff.
- Access, ability, and willingness to utilize technology, including an active email address.
- Provide feedback regarding the zipline and high ropes training processes, policies, procedures, and your experience as Course Supervisor to drive annual updates and improvements to the experience
- Timely documentation and communication to GSCB regarding the Challenge Course elements, equipment, use, or processes
