- Attend annual Girl Scout events such as Annual Meeting, Peninsula Day of Service, High Awards Ceremonies, Volunteer Summit, Earth Day programming, World Thinking Day, etc. as available
- Provide own equipment when photographing Girl Scout events
- Capture high quality photos of girls in action
- Edit photos, time permitting and as able
- Provide all photographs to Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay MarComm team to incorporate in our digital asset library
- Possess and maintain a business license
- Follow all processes and procedures, as directed by Girl Scouts of the USA and Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay.
- Facilitate pop-up troop photo shoot opportunities throughout the footprint.

**Training Requirements:**

- Complete 2 online courses: 200 Intro to GSCB and 200 Girl Scout Leadership Experience, if new to Girl Scouting

**General Requirements:**

- Current membership with Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay.
- Successfully completed the volunteer screening process, including background checks, training, and additional steps, as necessary.
- Participate in on going Girl Scout learning and networking opportunities.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- Access, ability, and willingness to utilize technology, including an active email address.
- Behave in a manner that upholds the Girl Scout Promise & Law in all interactions with the public, Girl Scout members, and GSCB staff.
- Provide the requested feedback surrounding all aspects of Girl Scouting.
