

Volunteer Position Description:

Gold Award Review Committee Member

Purpose: Provide exceptional support to Girl Scouts throughout the process of pursuing and earning their Girl Scout Gold Award.

Commitment to:

- Girl Members
- GSCB

Duration: One year (Reviewed annually by Council, optional renewal)

Responsibilities & Duties:

- Learn the Girl Scout Gold Award process via training and materials
- Complete Gold Award Review Committee Training
- Serve as mentor for minimum of four Gold Award Girl Scout candidates throughout the year
- Send welcome/introduction email to newly appointed mentees
- Must provide feedback on all submitted Gold Award Proposals
- Must attend at least four Gold Award Proposal Reviews Calls throughout the year
- Must be available to attend at least two of four scheduled Gold Award Final Report Presentations per year
- Must attend one Gold Award Review Committee meeting per year
- Must support one of the following: Gold Award In-person Trainings (quarterly), Gold Award Q&A Session (quarterly)
- Assist in disseminating information and opportunities around the Girl Scout Gold Award through community networking
- Assist in the recruitment of Girl Scout Gold Award Committee Members and Advisors within and outside the Girl Scout Community

Training Requirements:

- 200 Gold Award - Committee

General Requirements:

- Must be a registered Girl Scout with an approved background check.
- Must be willing to keep channels of communication open and clear by checking emails and responding in a timely manner and elevating concerns or questions when necessary.
- Must have the ability to communicate respectfully and provide positive constructive feedback with girls 14-18 years old and adults.
- Must have the ability and willingness to meet with girls, fellow committee members, and staff virtually or in person.
