

Crochet Dunk Bag

Make a slip knot in the end of thread.

Make a chain as long as the desired width of dunk bag. (About 84) This is the base chain.

Double crochet into 4th chain from hook and chain 1. Repeat double crochet and 1 chain in every other stitch along one side of bases chain.

Turn and double crochet and chain 1 in every other stitch along the other side of base chain.

Connect ends and chain 3.

Double crochet and chain 1 in the chain spaces until the bag is as tall as you want it.

Make one row of double crochet in every stitch to give bag a finished edge.

Cut 6 pieces of thread 4 times as long as the bag is wide.

Knot the end of 3 threads and braid. Do the same with the other 3 threads.

Weave braids in and out of next to the last row of crochet.

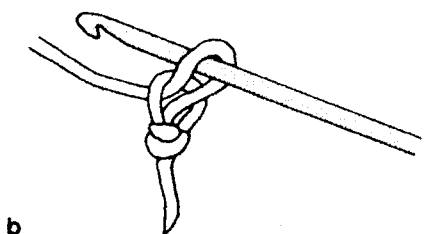
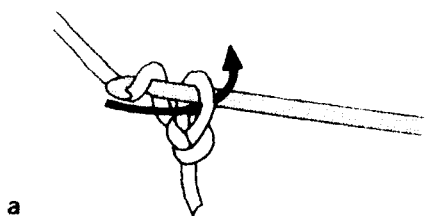
Weave the first one all the way around the bag, starting and finishing in the same place. Tie ends together.

Start the second braid on the opposite side of the bag and weave it in the same way.

Chain Stitch (ch)

a Wrap the yarn over the hook in an anticlockwise direction (or hold the yarn still and manoeuvre the hook); **b** draw the yarn through to form a new loop without tightening up the previous one.

Note: Unless otherwise specified, always wrap the yarn this way round



Double crochet (dc)

a Wrap the yarn over the hook and insert the hook into the work (into the 4th chain from the hook); **b** wrap the yarn over the hook, draw through the work only and wrap the yarn again; **c** draw through the first 2 loops only and wrap the yarn again; **d** draw through the last 2 loops on the hook.
