In the middle of the Delaware River just about the entrance of Delaware Bay lies Pea Patch Island, location of historic Fort Delaware, a place that is seeped in as much history as it is the supernatural. Fort Delaware is the final resting place for over 2,400 Confederate soldiers and ghostly encounters have been reported all over the island. As the sun sets over the Delaware River, take the 3 Fort Ferry across the river to the fort where local ghost story-teller and author Ed Okonowitz will lead you through the fort telling its history and more well known ghost stories.
