Why Flat Juliette? Every Girl Scout should know who started the Girl Scouts and how amazing Juliette Gordon Low was! The Flat Juliette Program is a fun way to get to know our founder.

The Flat Juliette Program is a penpal-type activity that promotes international literacy and friendship. It is based on the Flat Stanley/Stacie projects, started by a school teacher. As we gear up for the 100th Anniversary of Girl Scouts, GSCB's Flat Juliette makes her debut and begins her travels.

Each Troop will receive a Flat Juliette activity packet. These packets will include a Flat Juliette pattern, her uniform and a sample journal page to track Flat Juliette's travels and activities.

Flat Juliette Travels

Flat Juliette's Challenge

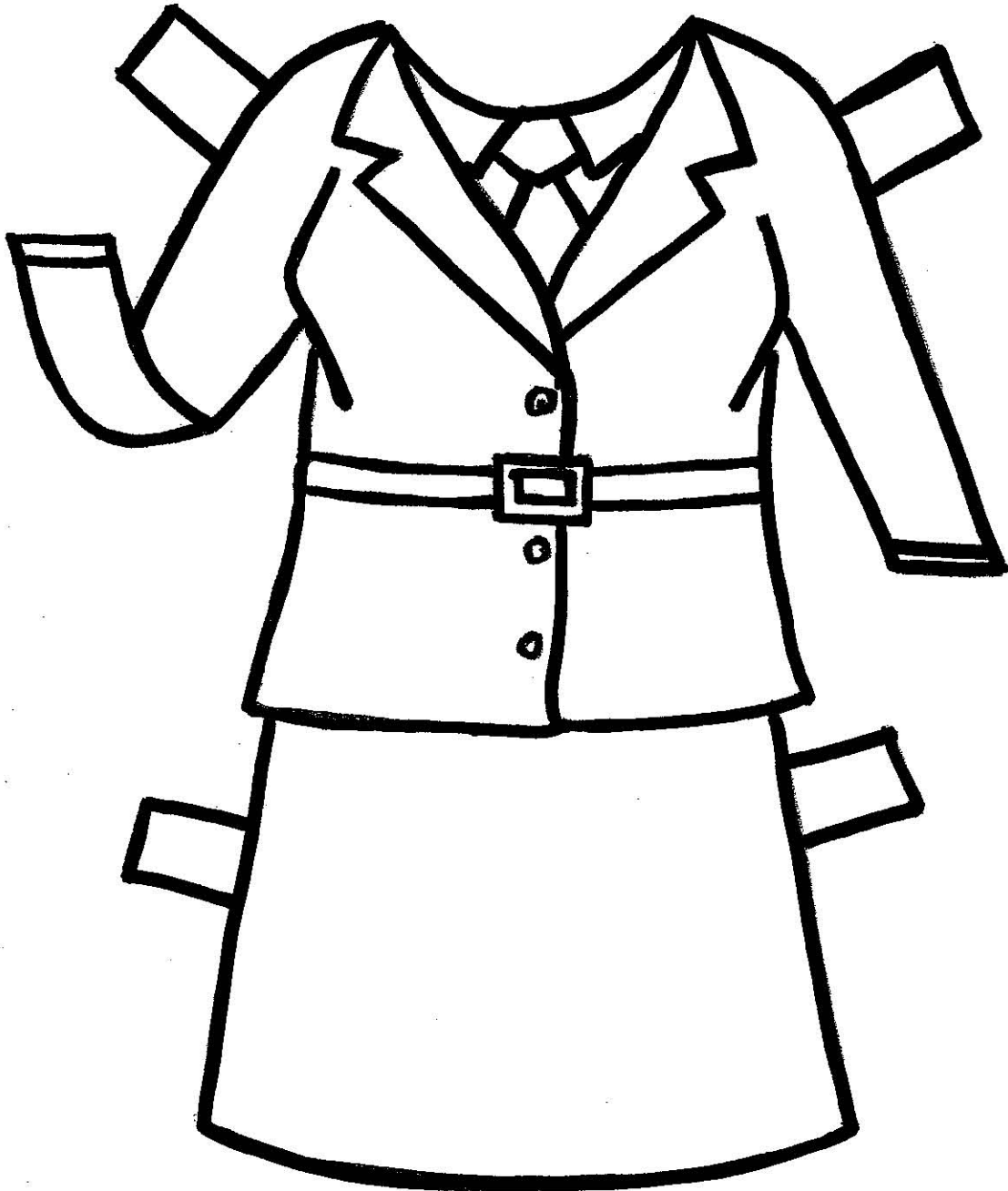
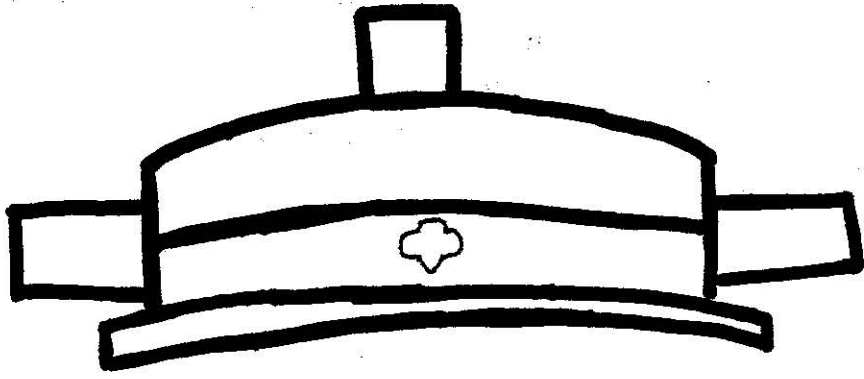
Keep Flat Juliette with you as you meet her monthly challenge. Each month, Flat Juliette will ask for advice on places to go, things to do or make, and people to meet. Take up her challenge, dress her appropriately for the activity and share what you did.

Suggestions for Flat Juliette Activity

- Cut her out of cardstock or poster board. You can even laminate her to keep her neat and make a stand or mount her on a craft stick to help photograph her.
- If sending her by mail include a cover letter with her describing your project. Include a return address label to facilitate her return to your proper address.
- Keep a notebook/binder of what is returned to you. (journal pages, photos, souvenirs, etc.), along with a map showing the places she's visited.
- Include something from your Troop to the recipient such as a patch, postcard, local map or travel brochure, a photo of your Troop, etc. This will give an idea of the type of item you'd like to receive from them.
- Here are some suggestions of activities Juliette could attend- 100th Anniversary events: Troop meetings and trips; an October Juliette Low Birthday Celebration; an Investiture or Rededication Ceremony; a Cookie kick-off and booth sale; camping or an outdoor activity. Juliette could even go to visit the girl's grandparents and cousins!
- Take her the Girl Scout History Exhibit at the Delaware History Museum. Have her visit someone that has been a Girl Scout in the past and ask what they did when they were a Girl Scout and take a picture with this person.
- Don't forget to send her on business trips with your parents or relatives. You can also try to get photos of her with politicians, soldiers, celebrities, entertainers, etc!
- Design other outfits for Juliette. Here are some ideas for outfits and accessories to get you started: doctor with scalpel, firefighter with a Dalmatian, tennis player with racket, artist with paintbrush, cowgirl with lasso, sailor with life preserver, construction worker with hammer, safari outfit with butterfly net, chef with whisk, baseball player with mitt or bat, zookeeper with animal, pirate with sword, karate uniform, Halloween costume, scuba gear, Greek/Roman toga, international outfits, etc.
