

Volunteer Position Description:

Service Unit Recruitment Champion

Purpose: To coordinate and facilitate the recruitment of new Girl Scout members in an assigned Service Unit through partnership with appropriate staff members.

Duration: Upon successfully completing a one-year appointment, you will have the option for reappointment of your role upon mutual agreement between yourself, Service Unit Manager, and council staff.

Responsibilities & Duties:

- In partnership with the Service Unit Manager, coordinate and facilitate year-round grassroots recruitment efforts that correspond with seasonal recruitment campaigns and help to meet Service Unit membership goals, as defined by GSCB.
- Help coordinate local volunteer efforts to recruit girl members, particularly engaging with troop leaders to fill openings.
- Help coordinate efforts to recruit new volunteers.
- Submit all girl and volunteer leads to GSCB in a timely fashion.
- Provide Service Unit recruitment report at Volunteer and/or Service Team meetings.
- Meet deadlines established by Service Unit Manager and GSCB.
- Be a positive voice for Girl Scouting in the local community, advocating troop and girl participation in all aspects of the Girl Scout Leadership Experience.
- Attend annually appropriate training.
- Follow all processes and procedures, as dictated by Girl Scouts of the USA and Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay.

- Successfully completed the volunteer screening process, including background checks, training, and additional steps, as necessary.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- Access, ability, and willingness to utilize technology, including an active email address.

- Provide the requested feedback surrounding the facilitation and execution of recruitment efforts.
