Volunteer Essentials

Summer is the perfect time to review our <u>Volunteer Essentials</u> webpage. Girl Scout program resources, guideline for running your troop or service unit, and more can be found here. Volunteer Role Name Updates

If you serve in certain volunteer roles with us, you may have noticed a name change in your MyGS account, or that your past role is no longer an option for you to renew into. We've recently made some changes to be in alignment with GSUSA standards, and to improve our data quality. What's changed:

- *Troop Treasurer* Per our Financial Guidelines, troop volunteers who are either in the Co-Leader or Troop Support Volunteer roles may be signers on the bank account and hold this role. Having this listed as a separate role creates duplication. While one of the signers on the account may take the lead in managing the accounting, it is imperative that troop financial records remain transparent to all troop volunteers and caregivers, and all financial decisions are girl-led.
- *Troop First Aider* While having a volunteer who is trained in First Aid/CPR/AED is recommended, the need to provide proof of certification is now on an as-needed basis, depending on the activities your troop is engaging in.
- *Troop Camping Volunteer* This role has a new name. To reflect the change in the new and improved training process, our Troop Camping Volunteers are now called Outdoor Skills Facilitators. In your MyGS account, you will now see Outdoor Skills Facilitator listed under your troop roles.
