

# Cookie Box Bank

## Materials:

- Girl Scout Cookie Box
- Scissors
- Tape or glue
- Money
- Pencil

If you have money, what do you do with it? You have a few choices you can make:

- Buy little items- buying a toy or a treat.
- Buy big items- buying a bike, new dress or video game.
- Make a donation- a donation is a great way to help other people and animals.
- Save for the future- saving your money is a a smart money move! Because when you need it most, you'll have it.

We are going to make smart money moves and take a cookie box and make it into a bank.



## Steps:

1. Cut the box in half, leaving one side longer than the other. You can use your pencil to mark the height of your bank. You will want to cut everything except the one longer side.
2. Put the bottom of the box together. Use tape or glue to hold the tabs down.
3. Take the longer side and fold it down over the box. Use a pencil to help you know where to fold.
4. Use tape or glue to keep the folds in place.
5. Cut a slit at the top of your bank so you can insert your money.
