


How-to: Penguin Bookmark



What you'll need:

- Construction paper (orange, white and whatever color you would like to make your penguin)
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Black pen/marker

1. Whichever color you chose for your penguin, cut into a perfect square. We recommend 6 x 6 inches.




2. From your white paper, cut out two circles for the eyes. Using the corner of your white paper, cut out the shape of the belly.

3. Using your marker or pen, draw pupils in your eyes.

4. With the orange paper, cut out two feet and a triangle for the beak. If you don't have orange paper, you can cut them out from the white paper and color them orange.

5. Set your smaller pieces aside.




6. With your square piece, hold in front of you like a diamond. Then, fold in half (point to point), making a triangle. Then, fold the bottom corners towards the top point, creating a square once again.



7. Unfold so you have a triangle again. Then, take the point of the top layer and fold it down to the bottom center.

8. One at a time, take the bottom corners and tuck them in between the layers.

9. Turn it upside down so that the single layer is pointing towards you. Using your glue stick, add your feet, belly, beak and eyes.



10. Tuck your bookmark into the corner of your book to save your place for later!
