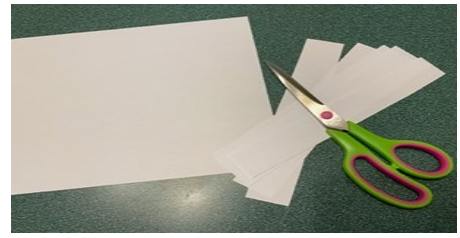


The (other lines) at an Amusement Park

I'm sure we all wish we could go to an amusement park right now! Until then, let's celebrate not standing IN line and create our own 3D paper versions of our favorite USING lines.

What You'll Need:

- Paper
- Scissors
- Glue/Tape
- Markers/Crayons



Instructions:

1. What are some of your favorite rides at an amusement park? Do you like the Ferris Wheel or rollercoasters? Maybe there is a slide you like or a pool you like to swim in. Make a list of a few of these.
2. What are lines that you can think of? Some of our favorites are vertical, horizontal, squiggly, wavy, straight, and zig zag. Can you find any of these lines in the rides your favorite rides you mentioned?
3. Cut out strips of paper about one inch wide. Now bend and fold the pieces of paper to create the lines you found in the rides.
4. Take a sheet of paper, this will be the ground of your park. Decide where you will put the rides in your park, glue or tape as you add them to the ground.
5. Draw yourself with friends and family, favorite shops or characters, places to eat, anything you want!
