



What is it?

DOC, also referred to as Digital Order Card and Digital Cookie, enables girls to personalize their own site to sell cookies online by inviting friends and family via email and social media. Customers have the option of having their cookies delivered in-person by the girl or have them shipped directly to their home! All girl-delivery orders require approval by a caregiver before the order is confirmed for girl-delivery. Caregivers are responsible for managing the orders that come in through their Girl Scout's site.

What activities are done in DOC?

Selling cookies online without the exchange of an order card and cash payment is a safe and easy way to ensure customers can get the cookies they love from the comfort of their home. Digital Cookie offers a mobile app for caregivers to help girls take orders in-person and at cookie booths too! The OCR (Optical Character Recognition) card reader ability also allows touch-free payments on the go.

How do I get access?

Registered Girl Scouts will be sent an invitation email starting December 11, 2021 for the 2022 Cookie Program to set up their account, download the mobile app and start adding their email contacts.

All users log in to their Digital Cookie account using the login URL: <https://digitalcookie.girlscouts.org/login>

All users who have completed their requirements will gain access on the 11th as long as they have completed the requirements.

Caregivers must:

1. have a registered girl participating
2. complete a Family Agreement

What is it?

eBudde is the online program management software system that keeps track of the whole cookie program!

What activities are done in eBudde?

eBudde is used to manage girl orders, payments, rewards and even more! Volunteers can manage the entire cookie program from the eBudde app or desktop version. Many volunteers use the desktop version to get the hang of the system and enter initial information and then use the app for the remainder of the season.

How do I get access?

The eBudde platform will be available as early as November 23rd.

Once access is granted, roster confirmation and ensuring all participating girls in the troop are listed in eBudde, is a Cookie Program Champion's first step in managing the program.

All Service Unit and Troop Cookie Program Champions who have completed their requirements will gain access as long as the requirements are met. Volunteers must:

1. be registered and background checked
2. submit a Champion Agreement
3. complete assigned training
