

Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay's Annual Meeting Rules of Debate and Voting

All discussion must be relevant to the subject which is before the Council.

- No member of the Council may speak for more than two minutes at any one time.
- No member of the Council may speak more than twice on the same question.
- Only members of the Council may speak on questions requiring official action by the Council.

These rules set the limits to speeches and debates so as to assure each member a reasonable and equal opportunity to be heard. They supplement the rules of order covered in *Robert's Rules of Order, Revised*.

Article VI: Election Procedures

- Election of officers, Directors-at-Large, Board Development Committee members and National Council Delegates shall occur by method listed below.
 - Procedures Bylaws Article VI, Section A - Members present in person, electronically, by proxy or linked by telecommunication.
