

Volunteer Position Description:

Board Approved Recognitions Committee

Purpose: The purpose of the Board Approved Recognitions Committee is to review and recommend nominees for approval, an alternate recognition, or denial of a nomination when the requirements have not been met or the criteria for the award truly satisfied.

Commitment To:

- Girl Members
- Adult Members
- Board Chair
- GSCB

Duration: Board Approved Recognitions committee members serve terms of 2 years with options to renew indefinitely.

Responsibilities & Duties:

- Discern that the endorsements support the criteria of the recognition nomination
- Recommend alternate recognitions that may be more applicable
- Maintain confidentiality of all nominees, their endorsements, and approval status
- Review recognition details to ensure nominee is eligible for the recognition
- Educate Girl Scout community on the recognitions and recognition process
- Promote participation in recognitions
- Provide feedback in a timely manner
- Participate in any Zoom calls for the committee
- Work with board chair to continuously develop and improve the recognitions process

Training Requirements:

- In-depth knowledge of GSCB recognitions
- In-depth knowledge of GSUSA recognitions
- In-depth knowledge of recognitions process

General Requirements:

- Current membership with Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay.
- Successfully completed the volunteer screening process, including background checks, training, and additional steps, as necessary.
- Participate in on going Girl Scout learning and networking opportunities.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- Access, ability, and willingness to utilize technology, including an active email address.
- Behave in a manner that upholds the Girl Scout Promise & Law in all interactions with the public, Girl Scout members, and GSCB staff.
- Provide the requested feedback surrounding all aspects of Girl Scouting.
