

Volunteer Position Description:

Community Initiatives Volunteer

Purpose: To serve as a hands-on educator for girls in Community Initiatives sites as assigned by the Program team to support Girl Scouting programming as part of in-school education.

Commitment To:

- Girl Members
- GSCB

Duration: This role is renewable annually based on GSCB needs.

Responsibilities & Duties:

- Lead 8-week program blocks in assigned sites
- Deliver engaging, relevant, and age-appropriate programming to girls
- Take attendance during each session
- Promptly submit attendance to GSCB
- Collaborate with GSCB Program team on questions, needs, and concerns
- Support overall program satisfaction by administering program surveys
- Communicate and build relationships with both GSCB and on-site staff

Training Requirements:

- 200 Girl Scout Leadership Experience
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General Requirements:

- Experience delivering Girl Scout programming
- Current membership with Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay.
- Successfully completed the volunteer screening process, including background checks, training, and additional steps, as necessary.
- Participate in on going Girl Scout learning and networking opportunities.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- Access, ability, and willingness to utilize technology, including an active email address.
- Behave in a manner that upholds the Girl Scout Promise & Law in all interactions with the public, Girl Scout members, and GSCB staff.
- Provide the requested feedback surrounding all aspects of Girl Scouting.
- Reliable transportation.
