

Volunteer Position Description:

Service Unit Outdoor Program Champion

Purpose: To serve as an educator and mentor for volunteers in helping prepare them for outdoor adventures which provide quality girl-led programming, progression, and enjoyment.

Commitment To:

Duration: Upon successfully completing a one-year appointment, you will have the option to renew your role upon mutual agreement between yourself, Service Unit Manager, and council staff.

Responsibilities & Duties:

- Advocate for participation in outdoor programming and events by promoting council events and ways to get girls outdoors.
- Support volunteers as they provide outdoor/environmental education experiences for their troops.
- Review and reinforce skills learned in outdoor trainings and importance of Leave No Trace.
- Help volunteers understand if or when they need to obtain additional insurance.
- Promote safe camping through use of Safety Activity Checkpoints and Camping Guidelines.
- Help volunteers secure qualified specialists for outdoor programs, i.e. boating, swimming, archery.
- Help develop and implement service unit outdoor events.
- Communicate changes in materials relating to troop camping to all service unit troops.
- Promote the use of all GSCB facilities and help to educate volunteers in the property reservation process.
- Serve as resource person with the service unit for outdoor/environmental education.
- Attend annually appropriate training.
- Follow all processes and procedures, as directed by Girl Scouts of the USA and Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay.

- Participate in on going Girl Scout learning and networking opportunities.
