- Participate in the planning and preparation of Annual Meeting components including but not limited to:
 - o Theme, décor, and visual components in coordination with GSCB Marketing team
 - Coordination and planning with caterer (availability, menu, etc...)
 -responsibility of contracting and budget will be retained by GSCB
 - o Development and leading of meeting ceremonies:
 - Opening Ceremony including flag ceremony
 - Grace
 - Closing Ceremony including retiring of the flags
 - o Compilation of Annual Meeting packet materials
- Participate in logistical day-of-event duties including but not limited to:
 - o Venue set-up
 - o Assist with check-in
 - o Greet attendees
 - o Coordinate with caterer for set-up and flow of service
 - o Participation in meeting ceremony components described above
 - o Venue clean-up
