Volunteer Support & Resources

Service Unit and Troop Annual Finance Reports are now DUE by 7/31

July sure came upon us quickly! Service Unit and Troop Annual Finance Reports are now DUE. As a reminder, this is a requirement for ALL Service Units and Troops to complete between July 1st - July 31st, 2025. If you have any questions regarding this process, please be sure to complete the assigned gsLearn training titled "200: GSCB Finance and Reporting Learning Path" (access gsLearn via myGS), or email MemberCare@cbgsc.org.

You will be unable to submit the reports in Volunteer Toolkit (for Troops) or via the Wufoo form (for Service Units) until the submission period begins on July 1st, as your records must reflect the time period between July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025.

Required submissions for this year include:

- · Completion of the submission form
- Attachment of:
 - -12 months bank statements
 - -Service Unit or Troop Financial Worksheet (all detailed transactions listed)
 - * GSCB Service Unit Financial Worksheet
 - * GSCB Troop Financial Worksheet

*All SU or Troops should maintain 2 years of receipts and detailed transaction documents at all times.

Mandated Reporter Training for ALL Volunteer Roles

There are very strict protocols for all Youth Serving Organizations regarding Child Abuse and Neglect, and as the safety of our Girl Scouts youth members is our top priority, GSUSA has placed the requirement that all Volunteers are expected to receive and abide by the mandatory abuse prevention training course provided by councils. To be able to provide consistent training across councils, GSUSA has provided a Girl Scout Abuse Prevention Training course for councils to utilize in gsLearn.

For Girl Scouts of the Chesapeake Bay, this training is now included in our learning path titled 200: Mandated Reporter and Abuse Prevention, which also includes our GSCB specific policy and procedure.

ACTION:

- 1. Complete the training by 7/31 to count towards Early Bird Bonus goals or 9/30/25 latest to remain in your active volunteer roles in MY26:
 - a. This Learning Path has been assigned to all volunteers and has been added to the Content Library for ease of access.
 - b. To fulfil the training requirement for councils, this is now an annual requirement for these roles which must be completed in order to be placed / renewed into a volunteer role.

- b. GSCB.org / Volunteer Essentials / Keeping Girls Safe
- c. GSCB Volunteer Mandated Reporter Policy and Procedures


